MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

John 17:9-23

In the book of John, Jesus prays for His disciples. He prays not that God would not take us out of the world but that He would Keep us from the Evil One.

In some traditions make Faith a kind of "escapism", where we completely remove ourselves from every association where we might face temptation as we walk through life in the presence of "sinners".

But that's not what Wesley believed. Wesley believed in a loving and forgiving God, One who is strong yet leads with tender mercies. Wesley taught THAT God "sanctifies" His people.....He removes from us the desires for the wrongful things we used to do, so that we no longer yearn for the things or the associations of our past but rather seek out the wholesome and holy things God places before us. We yearn to be in His presence throughout our days. We shun the things that could lead to sin. But we do not shun those enslaved by sin....we reach out and lovingly lead then to repentance and relationship with our God, trusting His Spirit to warn us that sin is standing at our doors so that we may flee its grasp and remain focused on Him. We know if we fall unintentionally, He will forgive and restore us.

Let our prayer be "Father do not allow me to use my faith to escape my calling in the world. Instead keep me from engaging in the wrong I see. Sanctify my by Your words of truth. Amen."


